Here at Broadstone Middle School, we are passionate about providing opportunities for our young learners to discover what they love and find the things they are great at. Our University of Broadstone Curriculum is one way that we can provide those opportunities.

## **Study modules on offer:**

Our University study modules offer variety and diversity, beyond the constraints of the national curriculum offered to schools. We expect our young learners to take risks and be brave in their selections, choosing new and exciting projects that they may not have tried or considered before.

## **The curriculum structure:**

UBC takes place one afternoon per week and each module lasts 9 weeks. The final week is our showcase day where our young learners will demonstrate what they have learned. This will generally involve the community and they will be some opportunities for parents to also engage in the learning. Although we are unable to say that we will definitely be able to run our UBC modules from the start of September due to Government guidelines, we aim to plan as effectively as possible now so that we can start the modules when it is appropriate to do so.

## **Making choices:**
